# Purpose and Outcomes

- Council discussion about structural approaches to providing emergency relief



### **Process**

- Public Outreach (begun and ongoing)
- Council discussion (early March)
- Council work session to review proposed approaches (April)
- Action Item at City Council to approve emergency relief programs (April/May)
- Program development and administration (Spring)
- Implementation applications available and relief payments begin (Spring)
