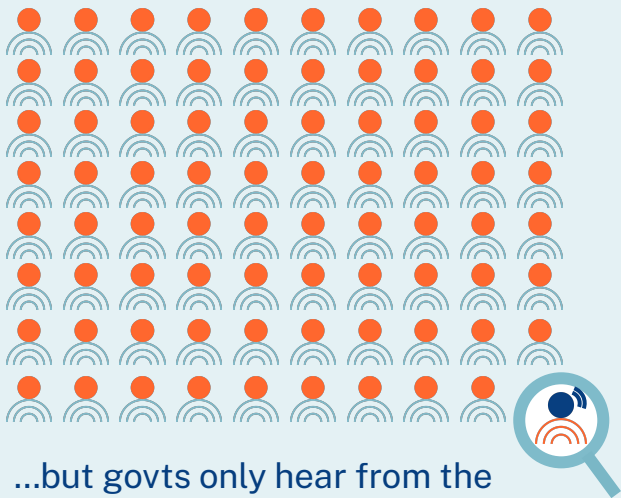

- 
- Residents don't feel **heard or represented**
 - Decisions shaped by **loudest voices**
 - Decisions made with **incomplete knowledge**
 - Governments always **reacting and defending**

What causes the **Participation Gap?**

1 Public meetings have limited reach

Some residents can't attend; others want to participate on their own time

2 One-off planning projects to “check the box”

Engagement is sporadic, removed from outcomes, and feels transactional

3 Hard to tie feedback to decisions and impact

Governments don't have time to analyze and integrate the feedback they do collect

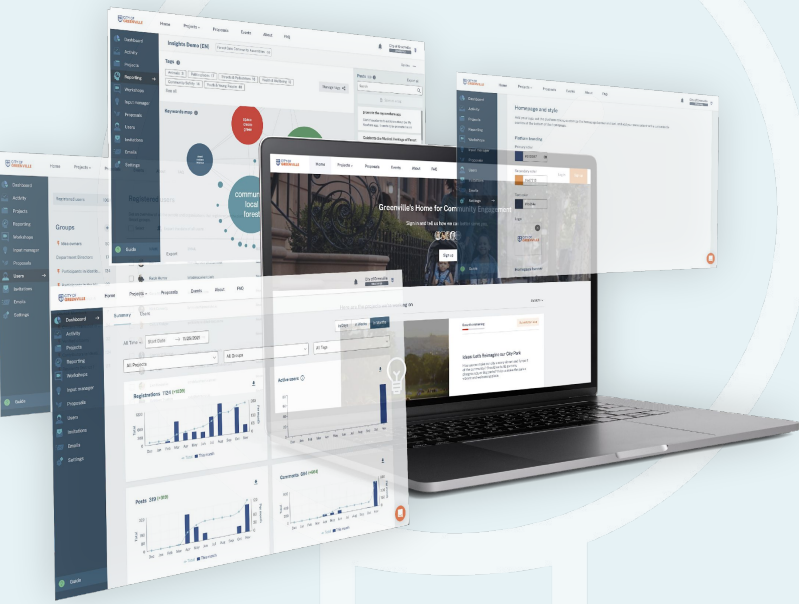

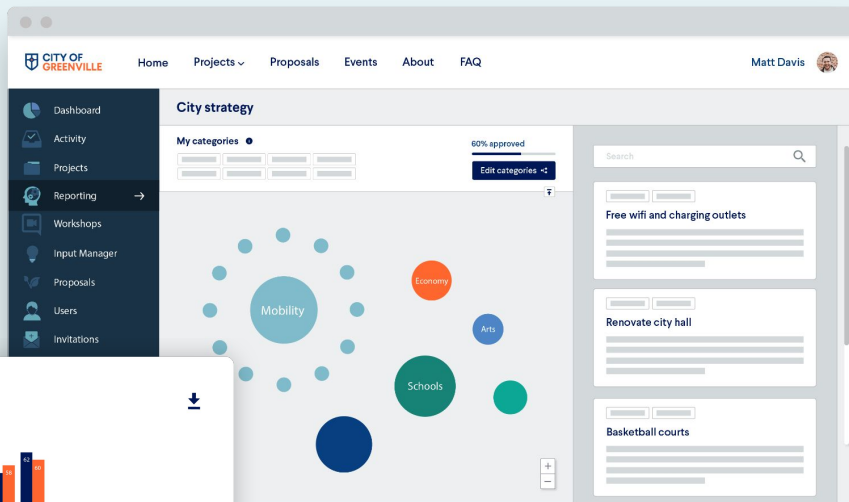
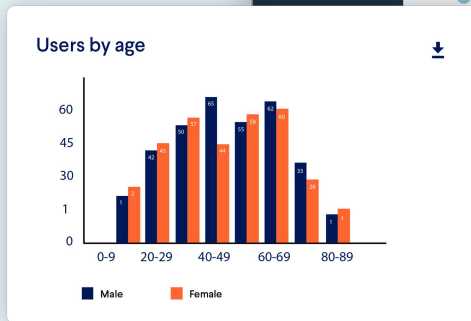

City of Lancaster, PA



Lancaster tackled their digital divide and increased engagement from **underrepresented communities by 13x.**

40% of Lancaster identifies as hispanic; prior online engagement was limited due to language barriers and uneven internet access.

CitizenLab helped develop a multilingual offline engagement strategy so city could host hard conversations online.

Valley Regional Transit (VRT)

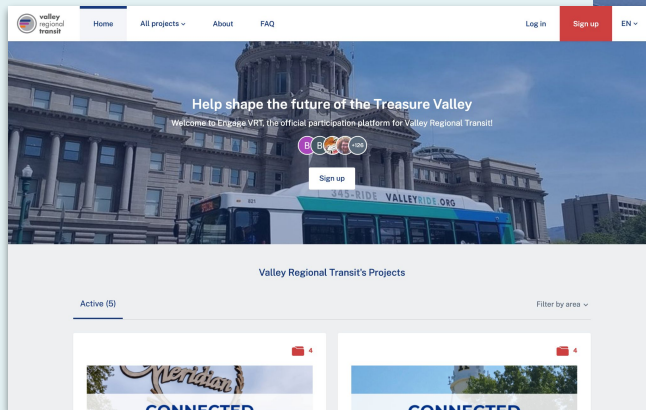


VRT is managing multi-stakeholder engagement across 6 cities to meet new population growth.

Treasure Valley, ID is growing fast, and VRT needs to prepare for this population influx and its anticipated mobility challenges.

With CitizenLab, VRT shares feedback data and collaborates with local governments, minimizing duplication and engagement fatigue. VRT is also designing projects just for transit riders, ensuring those that use (or want to use) their services can be prioritized.

ARPA Funding

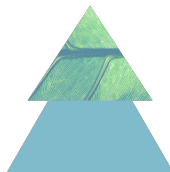
Lancaster, PA engaged hundreds of residents to discuss and prioritize 20 funding areas for upcoming ARPA spending.

Climate Action Plan

Manitoba's Climate Action Team is co-designing the province's new CAP using resident feedback.

Local Placemaking

A Philadelphia BID mapped residents' memories, turning them into physical landmarks, effectively annotating an entire neighborhood.
