8 9	WHEREAS,	the Maryland Code, Local Government Article, Section 5–202, as amended, authorizes the legislative body of each municipal corporation in the State of
10		Maryland to pass ordinances that such legislative body deems necessary to assure
11		the good government of the municipality, to protect and preserve the
12 13		municipality's rights, property and privileges, to preserve peace and good order, to secure persons and property from danger and destruction, and to protect the
13 14		health, comfort, and convenience of the citizens of the municipality;

16	WHEREAS,	Section C3-1 of the City Charter states that the Council has the power to pass all
17 18		such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution and laws of the State of Maryland as it may deem necessary for the good government of the City, for the protection
18 19		and preservation of the City's property, rights, and privileges, for the preservation
20		of peace and good order, for securing persons and property from violence, danger
21		or destruction, and for the protection and promotion of the health, safety, comfort,
22 23		convenience, welfare, and happiness of the residents of and visitors in the City; and

25	WHEREAS,	the Mayor and Council, have determined that it is in the public interest to increase
26		the fine for violations associated with parking unlawfully in designated
27 28		handicapped spaces.
28 29	NOW,	THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Hyattsville
30	in regular session assembled that Chapter 114 of the City Code be amended as follows:

5	A. No person shall stand or park a vehicle in any parking space on public or private property
6 7	designated as parking reserved for the physically handicapped with the proper signs or markings posted in conformance with the sign standards in the Maryland Manual, unless said vehicle displays a special
8	registration plate or permit issued by the State of Maryland or Prince George's County with a "handicapped"
9	or other appropriate designation.

1	B. Violations of this subsection 114-72 shall be punishable as misdemeanors, and the fine for each
2	violation shall be \$250 500.

4	C. Nothing in this subsection is meant to relieve persons with proper signs re handicaps from paying
5	the fees unless they can demonstrate the inaccessibility of the meter for payment.

20	application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity
21	shall not affect the other provisions or any other applications of the Ordinance which can be given

23	Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable;
