I have been a Hyattsville resident since 2016. I am Senior Project Architect and Chief of Staff at McCrery Architects in Washington, D.C., and I hold Master's Degrees in Architecture and Urban Design and a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from the University of Notre Dame. I am a licensed architect in Maryland, an accredited member of the Congress for the New Urbanism, a member of the organization Strong Towns, and a member of the Institute of Classical Art and Architecture. I have also served as a studio instructor at the Catholic University of America School of Architecture and Planning, and I am a frequent studio juror for architecture and urban design studios at both CUA and the University of Maryland. My professional experience includes master planning work for several cities - including Ventura, California - as well as several college and school campuses. All of this work demonstrates a knowledge of and commitment to practices and policies that foster livable, beautiful, sustainable, walkable, affordable, and productive environments. I want to continue to offer my talents and expertise as an architect and urban designer in service to the City of Hyattsville through the Planning Committee in order to help guide city leaders and local developers toward creating places which will continue to support the vibrancy and smart growth of our city as it continues to grow and change.

I have served on the Planning Advisory Committee for two terms.
