## SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

This is a request to establish a dedicated fund for removal of invasive species along the NWB between West Hyattsville Metro and the Duck Pond. This funding will provide an initial deposit, however, the fund establishes investment in invasive species remediation as a priority for business and development interests in both corridors. The expectation is that the City can follow-up with Kaiser, UIP, Gilbane, etc. on investing in the long term care of the NWB. This also is a request to collaborate with MNCPPC on the disbursement and utilization of the fund.
