14 15 16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS , Maryland Code, Economic Development Article, Section 4-706(a) provides that, in an arts district: (1) each qualifying residing artist is eligible for the income tax subtraction modification under Section 10-207(v) of the Tax-General Article; (2) the property tax credit under Section 9-240 of the Tax-Property Article applies; and (3) the exemption from the admissions and amusement tax under Section 4-104 of the Tax-General Article applies; and
21 22 23	WHEREAS , Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 24.05.26.04(H) provides that the designation may be valid for a period of up to ten (10) years; and
24 25 26	WHEREAS , COMAR 24.05.26.08(C) states that a "political subdivision may request redesignation of all or a portion of the designated district before the end of the 10-year designation period" and the new 10-year designation period shall begin immediately upon the redesignation; and
27 28 29	WHEREAS , the Gateway Arts and Entertainment District was last designated as such in 2011; and
30 31 32	WHEREAS, the time by which to apply for recertification is approaching; and
33 34 35	WHEREAS , it is the sense of the Mayor and City Council that the designation should continue as it benefits the citizens of the City of Hyattsville; and
36 37 38 39	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED , that the City of Hyattsville approves requests that the Gateway Arts and Entertainment District be designated by the Secretary for an additional 10-year period, to begin on the day of the designation;
