

## Project

Research, community engagement, and placemaking recommendations at the existing park, influenced by the artist David C Driskell. NDC will facilitate a community-engaged process to ensure that the City's desire for short term art initiatives and placemaking elements are accommodated for a spring ribbon-cutting as the team moves forward with a park design incorporating permanent installations that reference David Driskell's life and work.

## Timeline

This phase of work would commence in Jan 2022 and conclude in approximately 4 months, to coordinate with the park ribbon-cutting.
