	I am a Theatre Teaching Artist and fully support this idea and any other	
	programs that directly put artists in our community to work. I am the co-	
	founder and current President of Teaching Artists of the Mid-Atlantic	
	(TeachingArtists.org), founded in Maryland! Teaching Artists have suffered	
	a catastrophic upheaval during the pandemic. Despite their crucial role in	
	serving an organization's public benefit and mission, they have been the first	
	to be fired, furloughed, or receive reduced work. Historically (even before	
	the pandemic), Teaching Artists were at risk, with the majority working	
	without a labor union advocating on their behalf. Primarily hired as part-time	
	or independent contractors, often paid by the hour or the length of service,	
	they face significant obstacles without the traditional benefits of healthcare	
	contributions, pensions, sick leave, and the security of tenure. The local	
	region has many arts organization partners. Hyattsville is home to many	
	artists from various artistic mediums who identify as performers, community	
	artists, craftspeople, cultural bearers, and more! We must support	
	Hyattsville and the surrounding area's arts organizations. They are essential	
	to a healthy arts ecosystem. Yet the arts ecosystem is very complex, and	
	sadly supports inequities artists, including me, are working to resolve. Art	
	organizations have missions that limit their ability to amplify and celebrate	
	all art forms and all cultures. Arts organizations have overhead costs that	
	hinder paying equitable wages to artists who are small businesses. Arts	
	organizations employ artists who live across the DMV, sometimes	
	overlooking resident Hyattsville artists. These factors have caused several	
	artistic colleagues to move away from Hyattsville during the pandemic to	
	communities that are more supportive and affordable for artists. Support	
	Hyattsville and the surrounding area's arts organizations; we must also	
	devise programs and initiatives to fund artists directly. We need specific	
	programs that support teaching artists as creative entrepreneurs and
