Hyattsville Crossing BID	Funding of start-up costs for Hyattsville Crossing Business Improvement District (BID). A Business Improvement District is an economic development tool that allows a geographic cluster of commercial property owners to collectively invest in activities that improve economic vitality. Common programming for a BID include enhancements to public safety, improvements to landscaping, programs similar to Hyattsville's Clean and Safe team, marketing and branding to attract customers to the area, and public events.	\$150,000	\$20,000	Funding would include organizational start-up costs, staffing and an additional work-order to provide the organization with technical services throughout its infancy.
