**RESOLUTION 2025-01**

**A Resolution Whereby the City Council Declares the City’s 2025 Biennial Election to be a Vote-by-Mail Election.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 8-3 of the City of Hyattsville Code, there is a biennial election scheduled for May 13, 2025;

**WHEREAS**, the election is for five Council seats; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Elections voted at its regular meeting on December 3, 2024 to recommend the 2025 election be conducted as a vote-by-mail election; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council believes the increase in voter turnout in the most recent vote-by-mail elections warrants that the May 13, 2025, election be conducted as a vote-by-mail election; and

**WHEREAS**, §8-4 of the City Code provides that the Mayor and Council may determine by resolution that an election is a vote-by-mail election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Hyattsville in regular session assembled, that the City’s 2025 biennial election will be a vote-by-mail election.

**INTRODUCED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hyattsville, Maryland at a regular meeting on January 6, 2025, at which meeting copies were available to the public for inspection.
