











Seasonal Turn, Whitelock St & Brookfield Ave, Reservoir Hill, Baltimore, MD, April/May 2021







# TRAFFIC EVALUATION

Using the Made You Look observation tool we observed an increase in pedestrians and other road users using the crosswalk to cross the road.

- Before install, only 28% of cars yielded.
- After install, 74% cars yielded.
- Before install, only 37% of pedestrians used the crosswalk.
- After install, 75% of pedestrians used the crosswalk.
