## **Complete Count Campaign for Census 2020**

### **Revised Marketing Plan and Timeline (3.20.2020)**

**Objective:** To significantly increase the rate of resident participation for the City of Hyattsville in the 2020 U.S. Census. The response rate in the 2010 Census was recorded at 75%, 114<sup>th</sup> place among Maryland municipalities reflecting a significant decrease in resident participation from the 2000 Census which recorded participation at 69%, 57<sup>th</sup> place overall. The City's goal is to raise the response rate in areas that have historically shown inaccuracies due to lack of participation such as: the Hispanic community, residents under the age of five, seniors, our significant immigrant population and low-income residents. This grant funding will allow Hyattsville to increase our Complete Count campaign efforts with aggressive and targeted community outreach communications. January – March the Committee launched an event-driven and advertising campaign. Since the onset of the Coronavirus, we have since cancelled our April 4 Hyattsville Census Day and moved the campaign online.
