- 1. Introduction of Committee & Guest Members (7:00 PM)
- 2. Committee Business
  - Approve of January 23, 2024, minutes
    - Maureen: Motion to Approve
- 3. Additional Questions & Discussion
  - MNCPPC Presentation of West Hyattsville Queens Chapel Sector Plan Update
    - O Maureen: What time are the folks from the county coming?
    - o Jeff: We were originally scheduled for May 21<sup>st</sup> but it is now pushed back to June or possibly July.

### 4. Development and Planning Updates

- Canvas Apartments (aka. UIP)
  - Projected timeline
    - Currently in Phase II of the project, Route 1 Construction commenced on 2/12 and should last about 6 weeks. Work will transition to Jefferson
    - 2. 16 Weeks for completion of both Phases
    - 3. Currently drywalling and completing interior finishes.
    - 4. Anticipated first move in scheduled for end of July early August
    - 5. Model Unit to be completed March
  - o Percentage Complete- Approx. 60%
  - Todd: What's the latest on the retail space? I'm hearing two tenants have signed lease agreements
  - o Jeff: I am not aware of the signing of lease agreements for the proposed commercial space. Per your request I will investigate further.
  - O Greg: Do you know off the top of your head how many parking spaces there will be?
  - o Jeff: Off the top of my head, no, I do not recall but I'll review the site plan and provide you with that information.
- Residences at the Six (renamed "The Six")
  - Projected timeline-Currently hanging drywall in units as of 2/16. Anticipated contractual delivery date is September 11<sup>th</sup> 2024

- Percentage Complete- 55%
- The Devon (aka Dewey)
  - Projected timeline-Formerly known as the Dewey involves 5 parcels with separate construction teams for each. Parcel 1 is managed by NRP and is proposing 361 apartments. That's currently in the pre-construction phase. Parcel 2 is managed by Stanley Martin and is approved for 136 stacked townhomes which is in the pre-construction phase. Parcel 5 is currently under construction of the 321 multifamily structures. As of February 16<sup>th</sup>, framing and sheathing is currently under way. Drywall installation is scheduled in the next two weeks.
  - o Percentage Complete- 10%

### Gateway West

- Projected timeline Multi phased town house development. Phase I is nearing completion with approx.. 148 units built. Recreational area is complete with Phase II underway.
- Percentage Complete

#### Riverfront

- Projected timeline- Townhouse build outs are essentially complete and will be shifting focus to Phase II the multifamily build out which will take approximately 2-3 year to complete.
- o Percentage Complete- 97%
- o Greg: What was the move in date next to the townhouses.
- Jeff: The townhomes are virtually sold out and construction wise they are nearing completion.
- Maureen: That is some good news. WE have been waiting for this one to go up for a long time. That was abandoned land for a long time.
- Todd: Pretty well occupied and the community is developing into a community. They had a community event this past Friday. If not 100% occupied it is pretty close.

## Sovern

- Projected timeline- Currently working on interior framing, plumbing and insulation. Anticipated first move-in is December 2024
- Percentage Complete- 53%

#### 5. Additional Discussion

- o Jeff: There are two projects not listed on the agenda I wanted to mention:
  - 1. Hyatt View: Located at the corner of 44<sup>th</sup> ave and Oglethorpe. They are currently in the pre-construction stage and will be breaking ground in the spring.
  - 2. Suffrage Point: The District Council granted the City a continuous for the detailed site plan. A new date was provided for oral arguments.
- o Johannes: Just a note please include the Fire Dept when setting up the tours of model units for these development sites. The fire dept is interested in

doing a walkthrough, specifically when it comes to fire prevention and medical services.

o Sam: I was wondering if you had any thought as to whether Primark would be coming before this Committee or the City Council?

o Jeff: No I have not received any communications from Primark thus far but I will reach out and see if they are still setup to move into the old JC Penny's
