


COVID-19 IS CAUSING A PARALLEL PANDEMIC

Police officers are at a higher risk of suicide than any other profession


The rates for PTSD and depression among police officers is five times higher than that of the civilian population.

The number of police officers who died by suicide is more than triple that of officers who were fatally injured in the line of duty.

Suicide is the number one cause of death in law enforcement.

2021: 15 fitness for duty assessments


Increase due to pandemic, civil unrest/ experiencing a lack of support from their communities
