#### 2. Development and Planning Updates

- Rhode Island Trolley Trail
  - $\ensuremath{\circ}$  Current project work includes excavation and concrete for curbs, gutters, and signals
  - Expect lane closures throughout project construction
    - 1. Permanently extends lane reduction of the northbound US 1 onelane from south of Farragut Street to Charles Armentrout Drive
    - Intermittent single southbound lane closures, weekdays, 9 A.M. to 5 P.M.
  - Reconstruction of full depth asphalt for road widening at the median of US-1 between Braxton Place and Charles Armentrout Drive
  - $\circ$  Installation of two manholes near the intersection of  $42^{nd}$  Place and Charles Armentrout Drive
  - $\circ$  Placing concrete for 5" sidewalk, ramps, curb, and gutter at the intersection of 41  $^{\rm st}$  Place and US-1

  - $\circ$  Question
    - 1. Marshall: Will the sidewalks be on both sides of the roadway. Sidewalks will be on southbound side (shortcake, various autobody shops), northbound side will be the multiuse paths.
- Suffrage Point
  - Planning Board hearing held January 5. Planning Board continued the hearing to February 2 as a limited scope hearing around gaining an

understanding of any DPIE and MDE permitting/enforcement matters (not relevant to vertical elements of development).

  - $\circ$  Models are close to opening. Waiting on final utility hook-ups

  - Two final engagement sessions were held last week: January 24 (in-person) and January 25 (virtual).
  - Up next: synthesizing data and drafting the plan. There will be additional opportunities to provide feedback on the draft plan in the Spring/Summer of this year.
