Hyattsville Elementary School

- After pushback from business community in PGCPs and constituents, the majority on the Council have abandoned plans to try to alter P3
  - o Dan in regular contact with County Council members and PGCPs to continue to monitor situation
- Timeline? When should we start facilitating conversations with neighbors/etc.
  - o This summer, Jason Washington is putting together RFPs. Next summer would be when architecture/design is starting
  - o Now through October (2023) will be getting industry partners in place
  - o October through summer would be time for community engagement (what do we want to see in the space, etc)
  - o Get Jason Washington back in front of the committee in September to discuss what we want to do in regards to setting up community meetings.
- Lessons learned from HMS build for getting messaging out to the broader community (folks who are not already in the school community, but possibly in the future)
  - o Connecting with PTA, School Administration to make sure messaging is open and multi-lingual regarding the process (HMS happened really fast – community engagement didn't really happen)
  - o Get PGCPs to Zombie Run? Can have a tent with materials/information.
- Swing space coordinator (responsible for move logistics, bus routing, etc) update to come.

Hyattsville Middle School

- Still on schedule
- Committee will have the opportunity to tour in April/May
  - o Dan to verify capacity on tours (if we meet on the tour, must be open to public)
  - o Logistics: Tour would be posted, meeting minutes would be basic (location, areas toured, etc)

Nicholas Orem Middle School

- There was a sewage main break that closed the school for 2 weeks!
- What does getting more funding for school construction look like? Dan Broder is having/setting up conversations with County Council, BOE, PGCPs staff to set up the framework.

- There may be a letter to the City Council to ask them to ask the County Council to support a specific policy
