- 4. Plastic Bag ordinance Letter of Support Discussion
 - a. Hybrid approach to reducing single use bags. Plastic bag ban at point of sale & minimum 10 cents fee for paper bags. Fees are kept by the business; it is not a tax. Ban includes compostable bags (they don't fully break down during compost process)
 - b. Some local businesses have expressed concerns; want more time to consider and prepare for this to pass
 - c. Will be voted on during the April 3, 2024 Council meeting
 - d. PG County also considering ban or similar approach to Hyattsville (one of the recommendations in the County Climate Plan)
 - e. James: Could the City facilitate a reusable bag swap? Some residents may have excess, others may have none.
 - f. HEC votes unanimously to support the Plastic Bag ban
 - g. HEC votes unanimously to approve the letter of support for the Plastic Bag Ban
 - Thaddeus will submit the letter on March 31
