Proposed revision to Chapter 52 Dogs and other Animals, Community Welfare Act:

Danny Schaible gave an overview of the propose legislation. Several visitors spoke in favor, cited County data on animal calls, Mary Sue Twohy will make County data available to committee after meeting with County staff. Staff explained that at this time the city's Code Compliance Department is short one inspector. The committee voted not to recommended to City Council, will revisit the issue at the May meeting if data from county is at hand.

Discussion of revisions to Chapter 113 & 114 Vehicles inoperable and Traffic:

Joe Brewer gave an over view of the problems with Junked cars in (as defined by city code) the commercial area off Alternate Rout 1 creating unsafe conditions. Staff will bring to the committee possible changes to the city's ordnance chapter 113 & 114 at the April 28, 21 meeting.
