Item Title:
IT Infrastructure - 4310 Gallatin Street Cabling, WiFi and IT Infrastructure

Suggested Action:
 I move the City Council authorize the City Administrator to execute a work order with Dataprise Inc. to re-cable the existing City Administration Building and increase the WiFi connectivity within the facility at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

Summary Background:
 The facility’s cabling network includes many original and terminated cables and as currently configured cannot reliably and effectively support hybrid work and/or public meetings.

The City is commissioning Dataprise, Inc. to perform the following tasks:

- Total New Network Cables: 322
- Network Switch Replacement
- Upgrade Applicable Software Licensing
- Stage and Configure three (3) Dell M640P Server Blades
- Cisco Meraki Wireless Access Points (WAP): 25

The project will take approximately ninety (90) days to complete, from time of Notice to Proceed.
