Item Title:

Contract with Verra Mobility for Automated Speed Enforcement

Suggested Action:

I move that Mayor and Council authorize the City Administrator to approve a contract between the City of Hyattsville and Verra Mobility for automated speed enforcement for a period beginning February 8, 2024 to December 31, 2024 pending legal sufficiency.

Summary Background:

Our contract with our automated speed vendor, Verra Mobility expired on December 31, 2023. The Chief has elected to renew the contract for one year beginning February 8, 2024, and ending on December 31, 2024, with six one-year renewal options. The cost per camera is as follows:

- 1-75 cameras = \$4025/camera
- 76-100 cameras = \$3925/camera
- 101+ cameras = \$3825/camera

The cost per camera is dependent on how many cameras the entire Regional Automated Enforcement Center has after all jurisdictions within the RAEC processes their renewals.

Approval and Execute Contract

Fiscal Impact:

- 1-75 cameras = \$4025/camera
- 76-100 cameras = \$3925/camera
- 101+ cameras = \$3825/camera
