## One Year Renewal of the Maintenance Contract for Skyline Technology

## Suggested Action:

I move that the Mayor and Council approve a one-year renewal of the maintenance contract for Skyline Technology, LLC for the City's CCTV camera system at a cost not to exceed $\$ 30,000$, upon the review and approval of the City Attorney for legal sufficiency.

## Summary Background:

Skyline Technology Solutions was previously selected through a competitive bidding process and awarded a one-year contract with one renewal to maintain our 27 city-wide cameras. The current proposal is to cover labor for one year on the Citywide wireless camera system.
